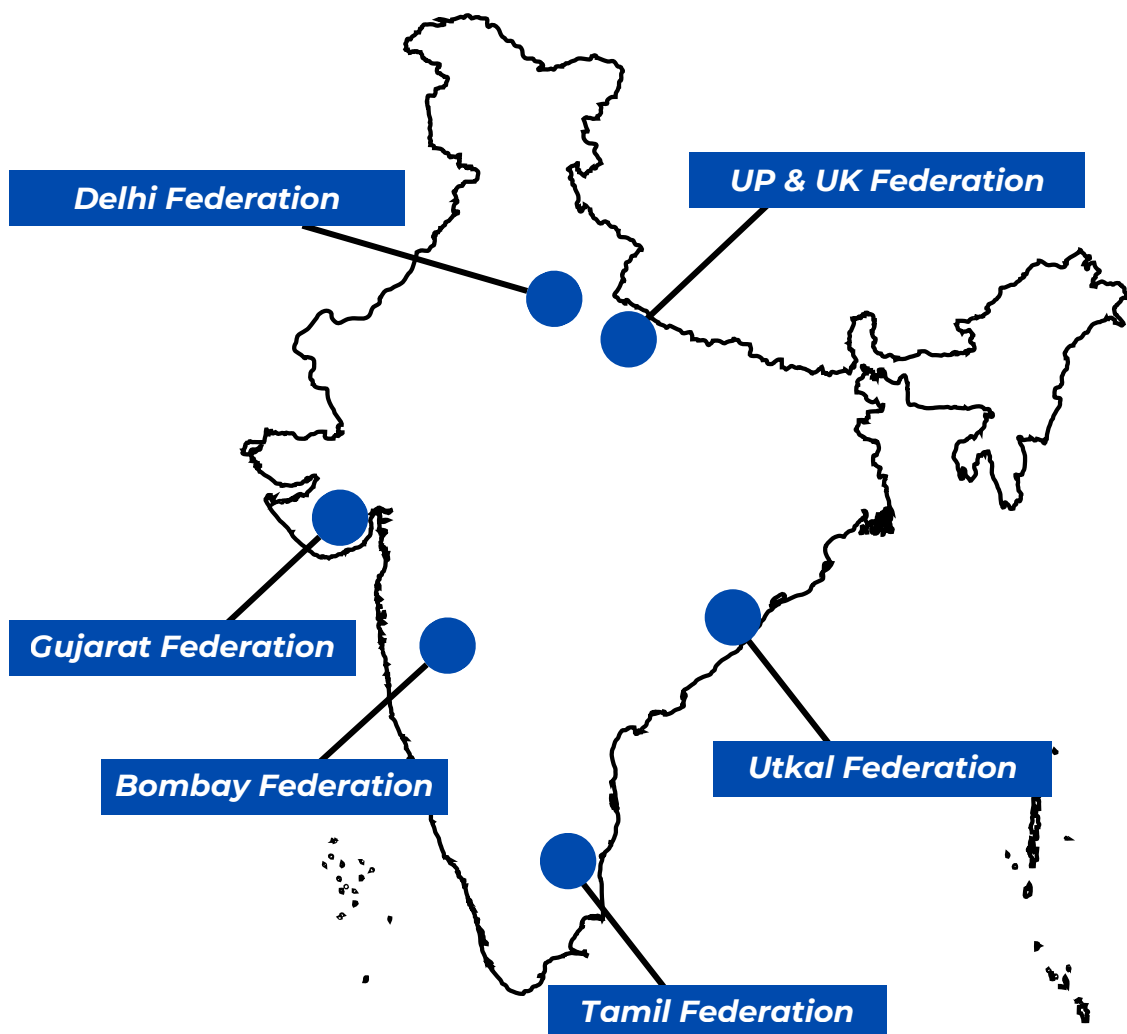

Gujarat Theosophical Federation

During 14, 15th and 16th November 2025 the 95th annual convention of Gujarat Theosophical Federation was held. It was hosted by Rohit lodge as it was also the Platinum jubilee of Rohit lodge which was founded in 1950 on 17th November. It is also the celebration to mark the 150 years of the establishment of the Theosophical Society. The theme of the annual adhiveshan of the GTF was: Theosophical Society stands for the World Peace. The venue was Dada Bhagwan Tri Mandir Complex, Adalaj, Near Gandhinagar with the facilities of the AC hall for the Program, Lodging and boarding for the 155 delegates from different Lodges of Gujarat Theosophical Federation.

The Indian section president Shree Pradeep Sinh Gohil graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. The BTF President Shri Vinayak Bhai Pandya and the Rashtrapati Awardee Dr Vijay Bhai Pandya also graced the occasion as the Guests of Honour.

The GTF President welcomed and introduced the Chief Guest. He, then delivered the Key note address on the Theme: TS stands for the World Peace.

The program continued with the Welcome speech by the Rohit Lodge President Mrs Rajeshri Shah. The greetings and messages were read by the GTF Co Secretary Shri Prashant Shah. GTF Secretary Shri C K Soni presented the account of the Activities and achievements of the Federation. Then the guests and the Executive Committee members were honoured with the Shawls and Bouquets. GTF President Harshavadan M Sheth then welcomed the delegates and delivered the short speech related to the success of the program.

At 12 noon the special welcome feast was served to all the delegates in the special Restaurant 'Samrasi' by the Rohit Lodge celebrating the Platinum Jubilee (75 years).

In the noon session short lecture series on the subject: 'The Contribution of the Women Leaders in the Development of the Theosophical Society' took place. Keshwar Dastur was the chair person. Rohit Lodge President Rajeshri Shah spoke about Madam Blavatsky. Deepika Pathak Ji of Sanatan lodge, Surat spoke about Radha Burnier and

Sushilaba Wadher, a very veteran President of the Krishna Nagar Lodge of Bhavnagar spoke about Dr Annie Besant.

Certain video messages were shown to the delegates before the tea break. Then the Public lecture started at 4.45

The Guest of Honour Shri Dr Vijay Bhai Pandya spoke on the Subject: Valmiki Ramayana: the Saga of the Infinite Values of Humanity. From the Chair GTF President Harshavadan Sheth introduced the guest speaker Dr Vijay Bhai Pandya. Rashtrapati Awardee Dr Pandya spoke so vividly on the Subject. What a spell bound speech!

At 6.30 the delegates dispersed for the dinner in the Bhojanalaya, one km far from the Program Hall. Five rickshaws were arranged during different times to fetch the delegates accordingly to the lunch and dinner and to the hall for the program.

At 7.30pm Brother Taral Munshi from Mumbai entertained the delegates with his art showing lighter gestures to convey the message of theosophy in an interesting and effective manner.

On 15th November, on the second day in the morning session at 8.30 Bharat Samaj Puja was performed by Rajeshri Shah along with Pratibha Parekh and C.K.Soni. Video messages were followed. At 9.30 short lecture series continued. The subject was: Effective Lodge activities lead to the development of consciousness. The chairperson was Shri Narsingh Bhai Thakariya. “First, a disclaimer: nothing in these pages is offered as a prescription. This book is not a manual, or a definite map. Rather, it is a reflection- an account of over fifty years of intentional engagement with what has unfolded into an ever-deepening spiritual Life. At the outset, none of this was assured.” The author who served as the International President of a world wide organization declares in the introduction of this book. So what this book offers? This is a spiritual travelogue of an individual . A journey to oneself. “Ekle Chalo Re 'or walk on alone. The famous words of Poet Rabindranath Tagore.

The Seven articles in the first Part ‘The Big picture’, points out a fundamental change in the human nature to understand Wisdom. In the article “The Paradox of Self-transformation” He says “In the absence of some shift in the centre of our awareness, a meaningful association with Wisdom is difficult to impossible. Our normal approach tends to be self-centred.” A study of comparative religion, Philosophy and Science is one of the three objects of the Theosophical Society. Br. Tim points out the similarity between great religious traditions , Hinduism, Buddhism, and Christianity. He says “Pick your tradition and there are specific steps that are enumerated. Yoga has its Eight Limbs; Tibetan Buddhism speaks about the graded path to enlightenment, the Lam Rim. Catholic Christianity has ‘The Stations of the Cross’. In a Theosophical approach the practice we emphasize is study, meditation, and service. These are practices in which we engage with the assumption that they ultimately lead to self-transformation.” What is self- transformation? Tim Boyd says “The process of self-transformation does have steps, but self-transformation itself is something very different. There is not a certain number of correct books, or of hours in meditation that results in the experience of transformation. In and of itself, transformation occurs as a very specific event..... People such as Ramana Maharshi, Jesus, Buddha, Muhammad and others led spiritual lives. They did practice, the study, and it resulted in an experience that they then tried to teach. They spent lifetime teaching, and everyone around them spent a lifetime.

The title of the chapter “ The solution to All Problems” is alluring to the reader. He compares the human mundane problems such as family problems, illness from headache to terminal ones. Flood to volcano eruption, storms etc. which are considered as total destruction by Nature. But ,our limited vision prevents us from seeing the things happening after the covering of the land with lava. He also refers to the problem of modern society called “identity theft” where one person takes the identity of someone else, pretends to be that person, and then behaves in a manner that creates financial problems for the real person. We are also identified to our nationality, religion, family tradition and so forth. But we have to come out of this narrow cocoons . Tim quotes the great tradition of Indian Sages “*neti, neti*” which literally means “not this, not this.” It describes the process of recognizing the layers of identity.



Regarding, the limitations of the material science, Tim states that “ 96% of the matter and energy in the universe is “dark”.In other words only 4% of all that makes up the universe is known to science. “ In this situation we are all in a condition similar to which St. Paul described “ The things I would do, I do not do, the things I would not do, that I do.” The same sentiments are reflected in the words of the character Duryodana in *Vyasa Bharata* “I know what is *Dharma* (righteousness) but I do not have the inclination to follow it. I know what is *dharmā* (unrighteousness) but I cannot refrain from it.” The condition of modern man is also not different.

The author states that ‘To the person who has that intense aspiration, the perception of this invisible, omnipresent spirit is a possibility. The book is very appealing to the seekers of wisdom, which is in an experiential mood.
